

### **Potter Heigham Parish Council**

Notes from the meeting held on 13th March 2024

- The Parish Council has been awarded funding for a traffic feasibility study of the Potter Heigham Bridge from Norfolk County Council's Parish Partnership Scheme. Funding covers 50% of the total cost £10,000. The remaining funds are being provided from the County Councillor's budget (£3,500) and the parish council (£1,500). The project will look at ways to make the bridge safer for pedestrians and vehicles. A timescale for the study has not yet been set but the council will keep you updated on the progress of this.
- The Annual Parish Meeting date has been set for 24th April 2024 at 7.30pm in the village hall. Do come along to hear updates from various local groups and there will also be a guest speaker from the Environment Agency in attendance.
