

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO6202) affecting the Bridge Road from 300m northwest of its junction with A149 High Road for 50m north-westwards in the PARISH OF POTTER HEIGHAM to facilitate repairs to damage of the bridge surface.

This Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 23rd December 2022 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 13th January to 14th April 2023 (previously 23rd December 2022 to 12th January 2023) for the duration of the works expected to be about 91 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: The Causeway, High Road, Yarmouth Road A149, Station Road, Bridge Road (Potter Heigham/ Repps with Bastwick).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
