

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO8529) affecting the A1602 Norwich Road from its junction with Pound Lane to its junction with Horse Fen Road (the "Road") in the Parish of Ludham to facilitate carriageway resurfacing, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) and traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 07:30 and 17:00 on 21st to 25th October 2024, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 6th December 2024 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via:

A1062 Norwich Road: (Norwich Road, Johnson Street, Ludham Bridge, Norwich Road, Upper Street, Norwich Road, Ropes Hill, Horning Road), A1151 (Stalham Road, Norwich Road), A149 (Norwich Road, Wayford Road, Yarmouth Road, By Pass, Yarmouth Road), A1062 (Station Road, Ludham Road, Yarmouth Road).

A1602 High Street: Clockwise route: High Street, Catfield Road, Ludham Road, The Street, Sutton Road, A149 (Bypass, Yarmouth Road), A1062 (Station Road, Ludham Road, Yarmouth Road). Anti-Clockwise route: High Street, Catfield Road, Ludham Road, The Street, Sutton Road, A149 (Yarmouth Road, Wayford Road, Norwich Road), A1151 (Norwich Road, Stalham Road), A1062 (Horning Road, Ropes Hill, Norwich Road, Upper Street, Norwich Road, Ludham Bridge, Johnson Street, Norwich Road).

A1602 Staithe Road: Clockwise route: Staithe Road, Hall Common, Hall Road, A1062 (Johnson Street, Norwich Road). Anti-Clockwise route: Staithe Road, Hall Common, Hall Road, A1062 (Ludham Bridge, Norwich Road, Upper Street, Norwich Road, Ropes Hill, Horning Road), A1151 (Stalham Road, Norwich Road), A149 (Norwich Road, Wayford Road, Yarmouth Road, By Pass, Yarmouth Road), A1062 (Station Road, Ludham Road, Yarmouth Road).

(Stalham, Ludham, Hoveton, Smallburgh, Hickling, Barton Turf, Potter Heigham, Ashmanhaugh, Catfield, Horning, Neatishead, Sutton).

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 6th December 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
