Policing Update for Potter Heigham – January 1st to Today

Since the start of the year, we've had **16 calls** from the Potter Heigham area, broken down as follows:

- **7 blue light calls** – Mostly road-related: collisions, a suspected drink driver, and an exposed manhole cover on the A149. There was also a report of a fight, but this incident appears to be linked to issues involving the same group in other locations that night.
- **3 priority calls** – These included:
 - A domestic incident,
 - A report of a bird of prey believed to have been unlawfully killed,
 - And cannabis plants found dumped near the river.
- **6 non-attendance calls** – These were either not police matters, resolved over the phone, or involved accidental/repeat callers.

Current priorities remain **retail theft and road safety**. Officers have been actively visible in the area through foot patrols and mobile patrols – engaging with the community as part of our “park, walk, and talk” initiative.

Overall, there's **nothing alarming to report**, but as always, we're here to support and respond as needed.
